


What is Amateur Radio?

To begin with you can use your phone or laptop to join in Echolink conversations or a handheld radio to make contacts via a local repeater.


Join a club and make new friends, further your knowledge and discover the many facets of the hobby.

They often help in search and rescue missions and volunteer to provide communications at community events.

You can gain technical skills while having fun with direction-finding to locate hidden transmitters, building circuits, experimenting with antennas or contesting whilst amongst like-minded people.
